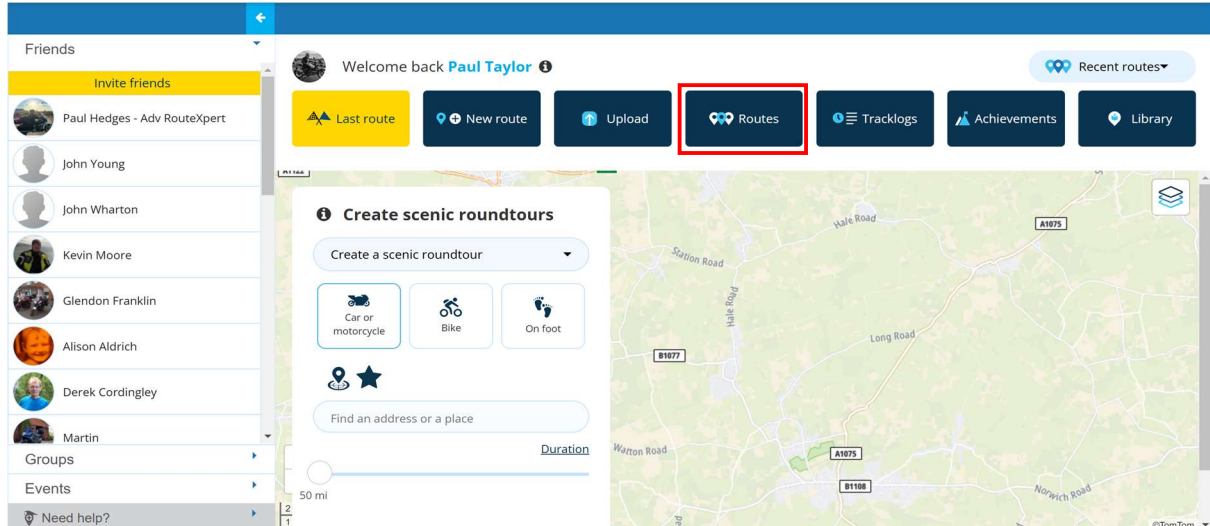


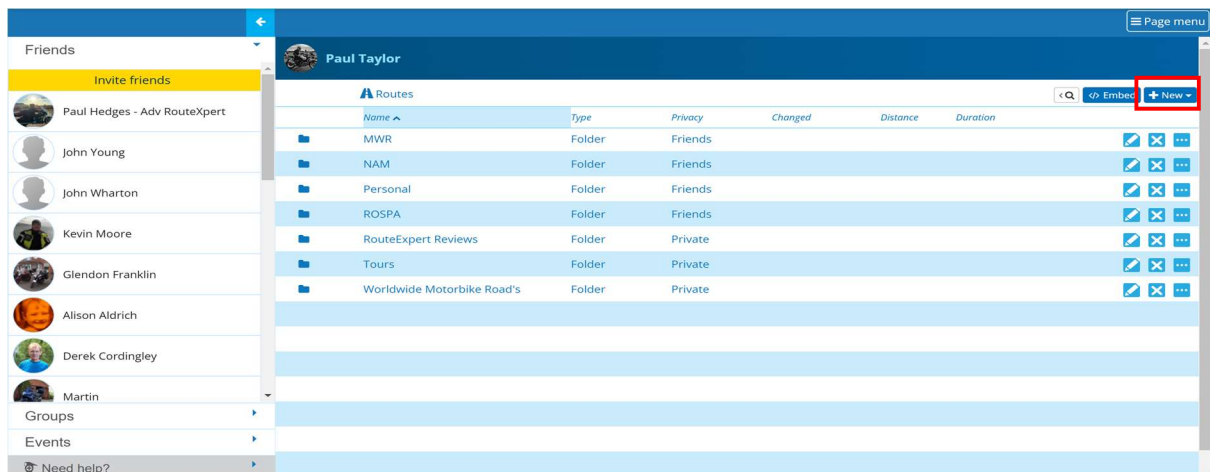
MRA Importing A Route

Say you have a route that was sent via either email or by another form and you want to import it into MRA, here is how. ("**WARNING/DISCLAIMER**" This is a gold members feature only)

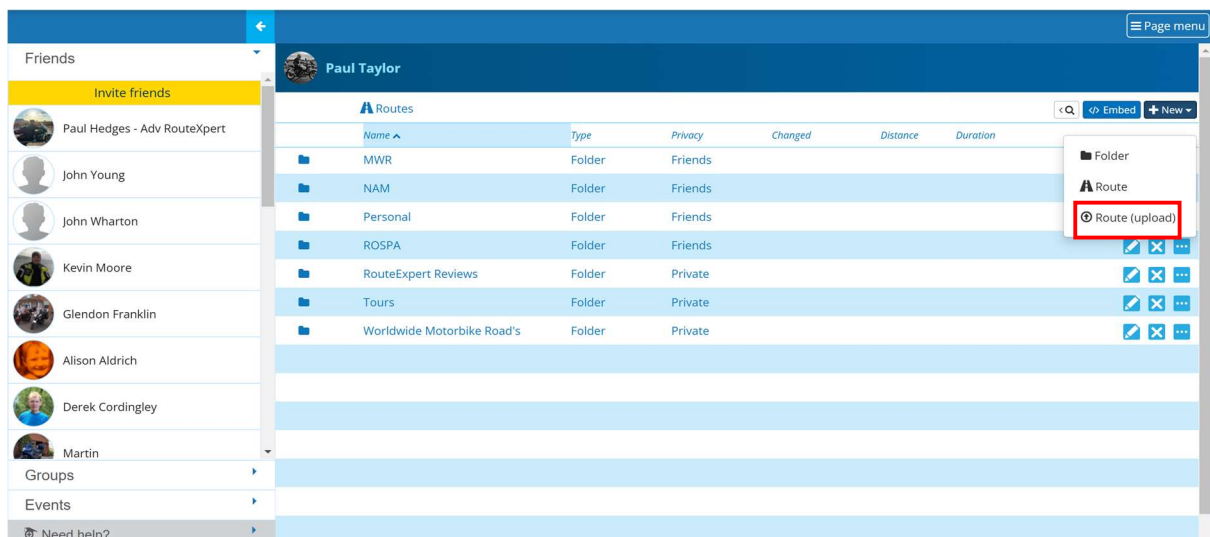
Firstly, you will need to download the .GPX file to your PC or Laptop remembering the folder location you saved it to.



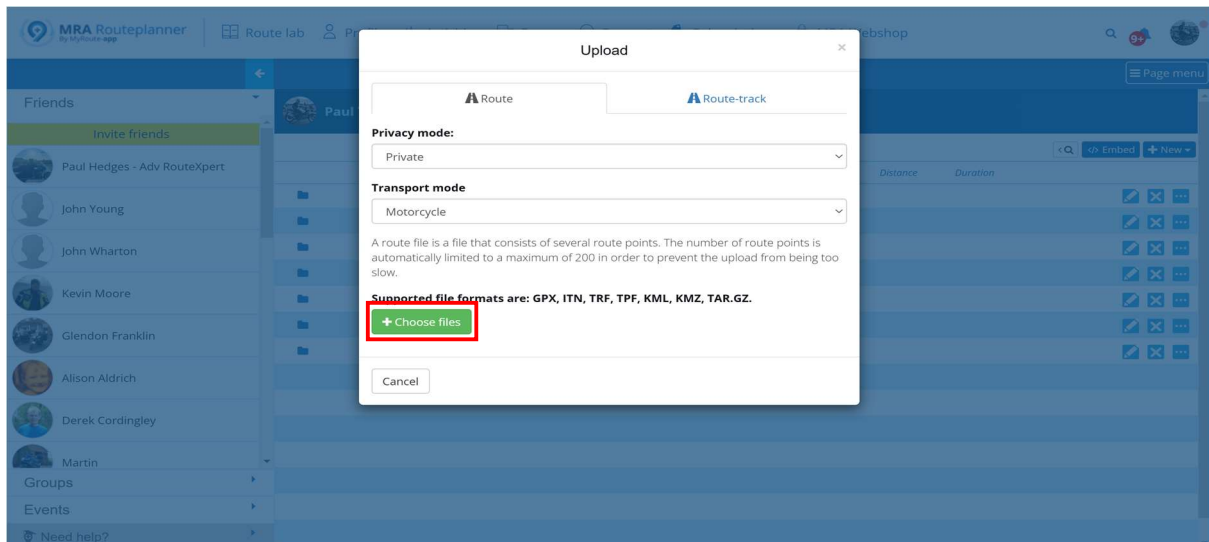
With MRA open click on the “Routes” button (As Shown Above)



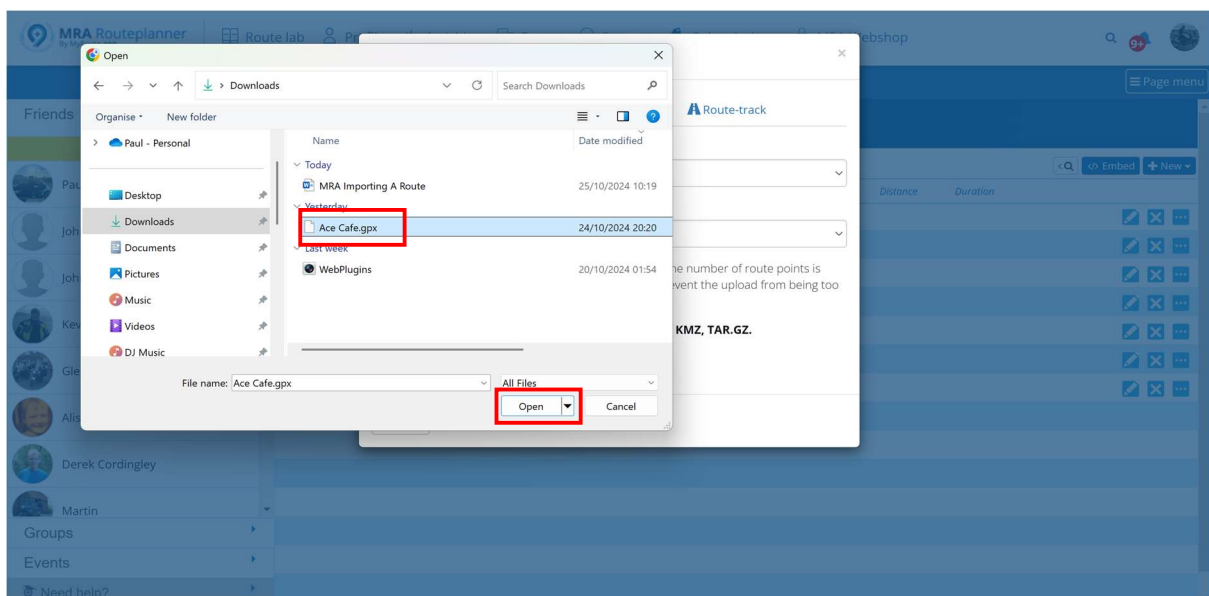
When in your Routes screen at the top right click the “New” button.



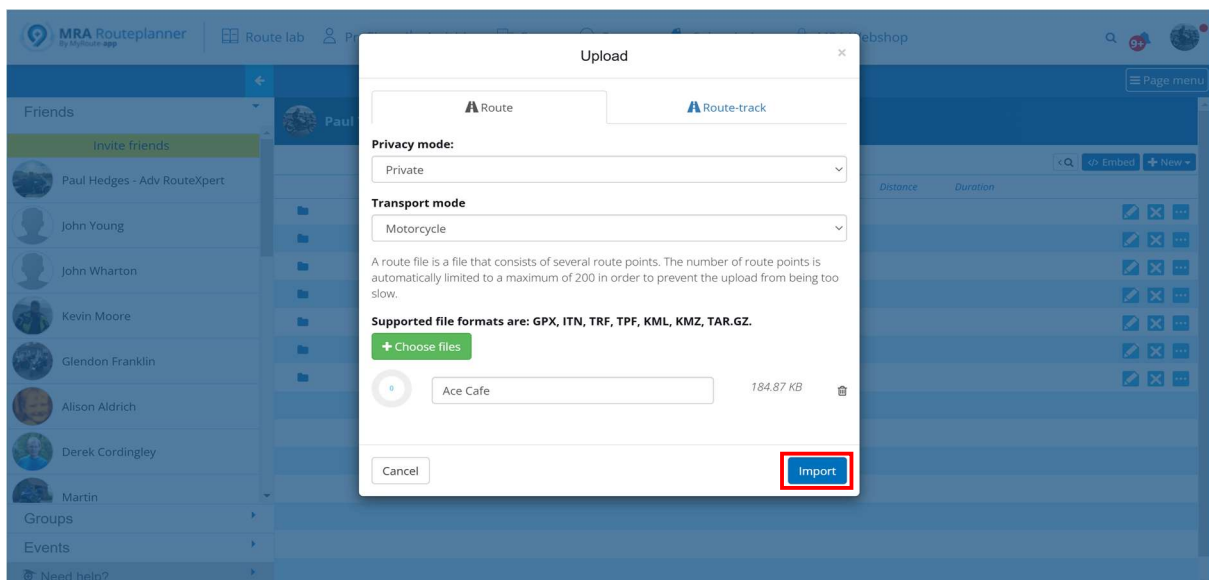
And select “Route (upload)”.



The following window opens, in here Select “+ Choose files”



This will bring up the Open window, direct yourself to the previously saved .GPX file and highlight it (Ace Cafe.gpx) then click the “Open” button.



You will go back to the previously opened window, Now Click the “Import” button.
