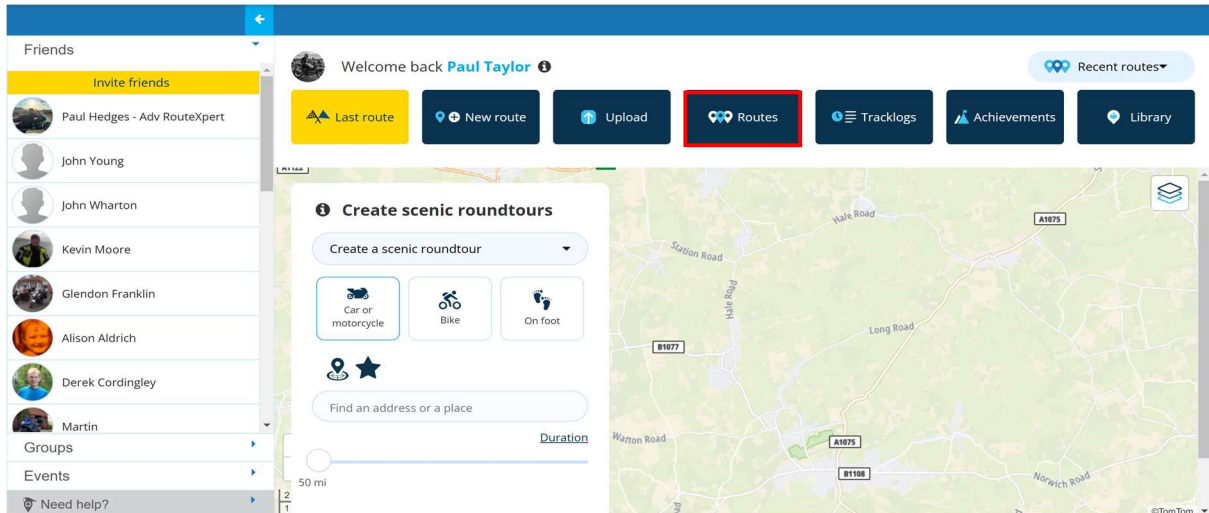
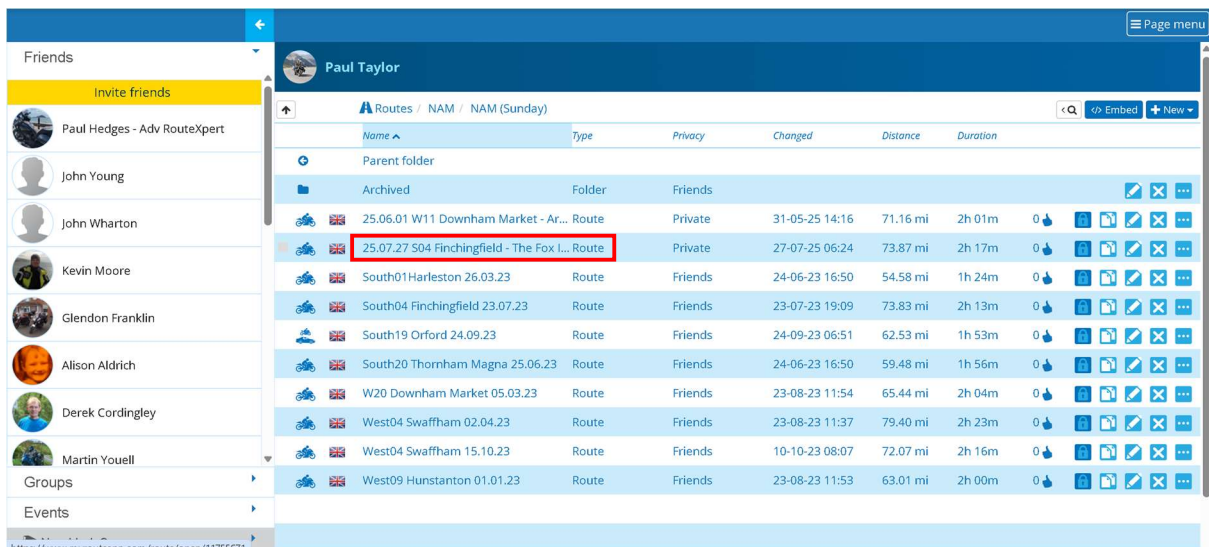


MRA Split a Route (Gold Membership Only)

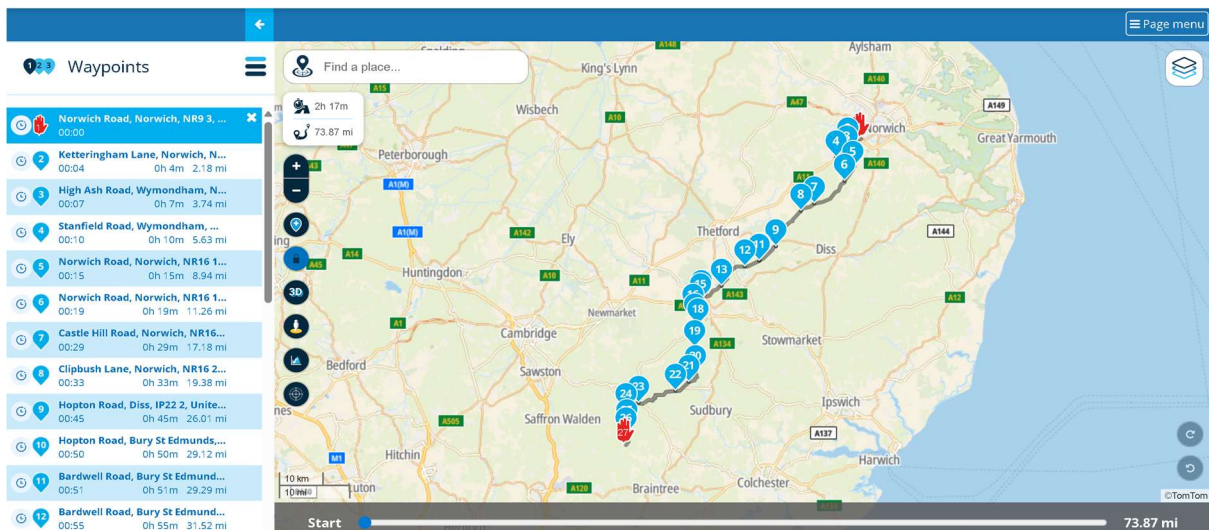
So, let's say you don't have a Sat Nav or a mobile device to view maps on. Then how do I take any current .gpx route within MRA and print a turn-by-turn instructions list to follow on my tank bag? (Note: A printer is required, or a memory stick to take .pdf to your nearest library to print at a small cost) ("WARNING/DISCLAIMER" This is a gold members feature only)



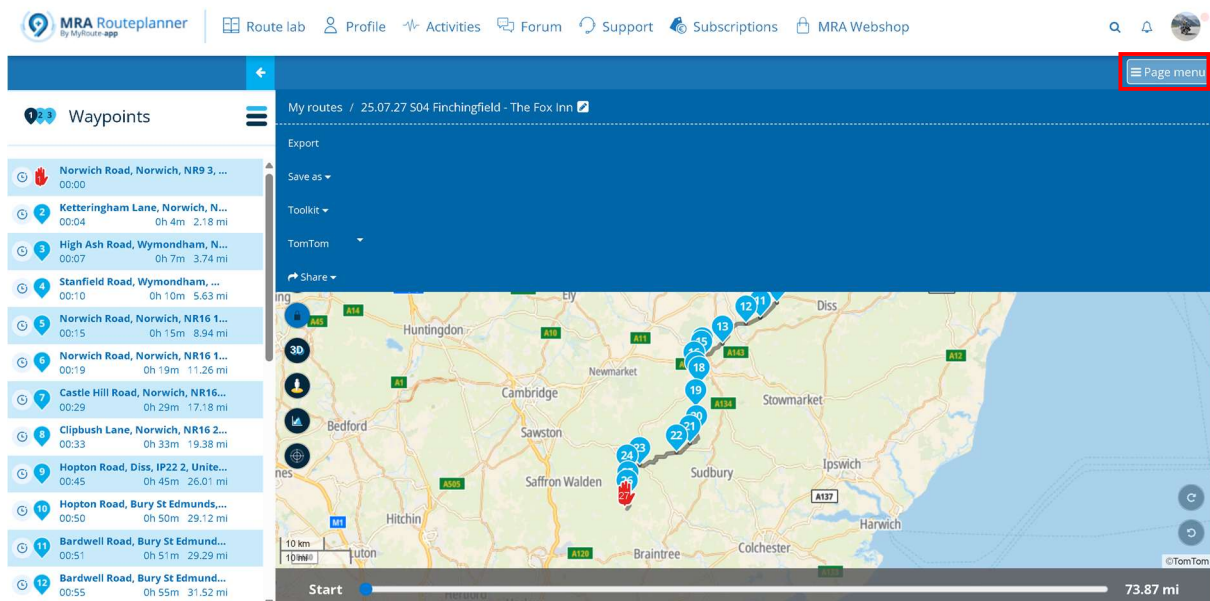
1. So, in MRA, click on the middle “Routes” button (As Shown Above)



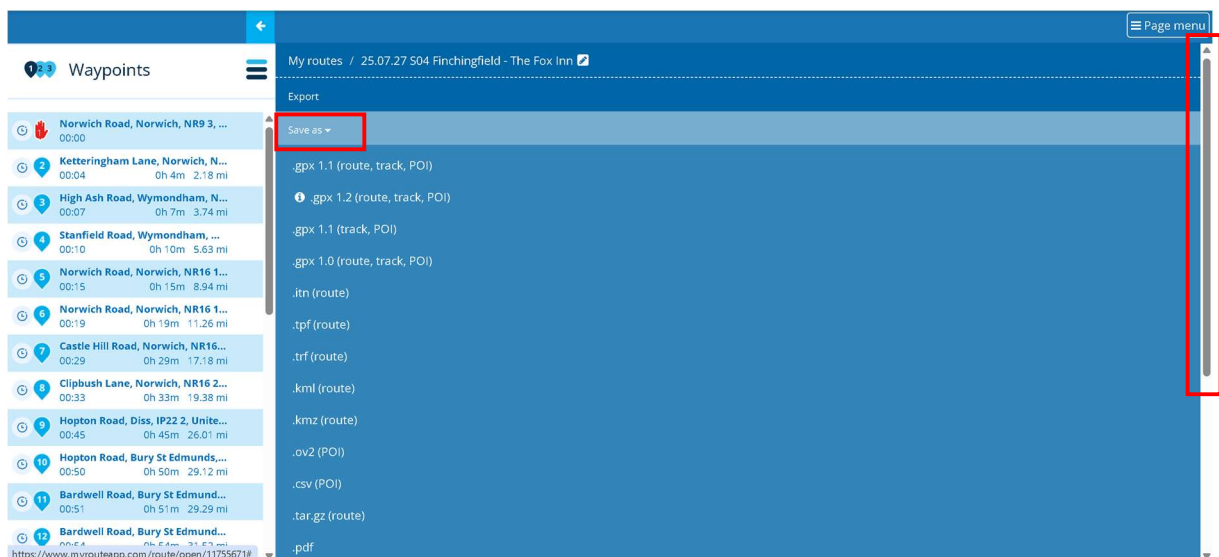
2. Select and open the route that requires the turn-by-turn instructions (As shown above).



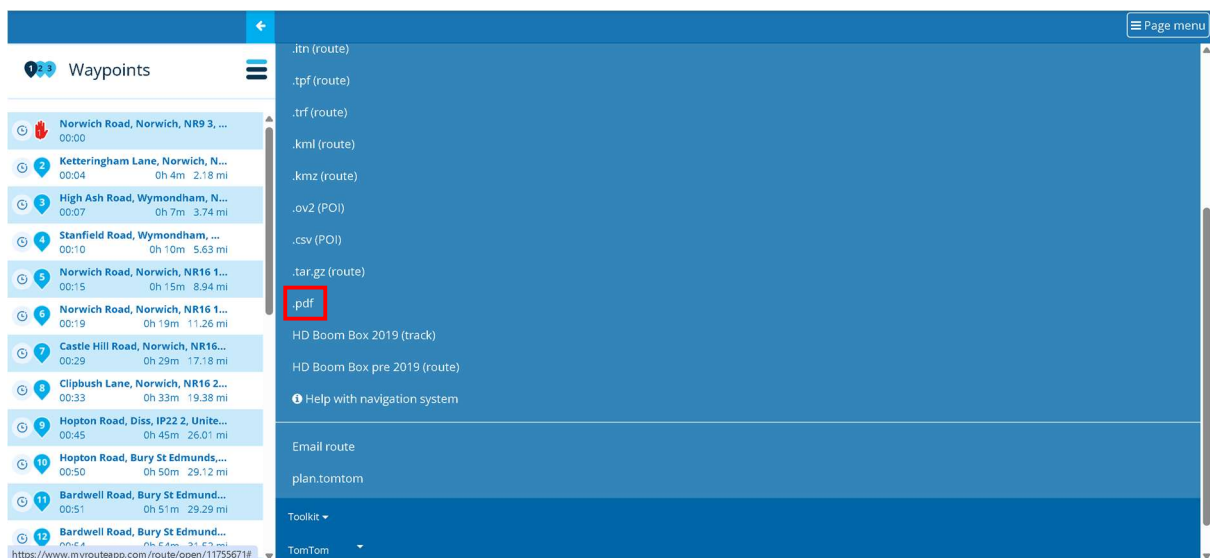
3. The following window will open (As shown above).



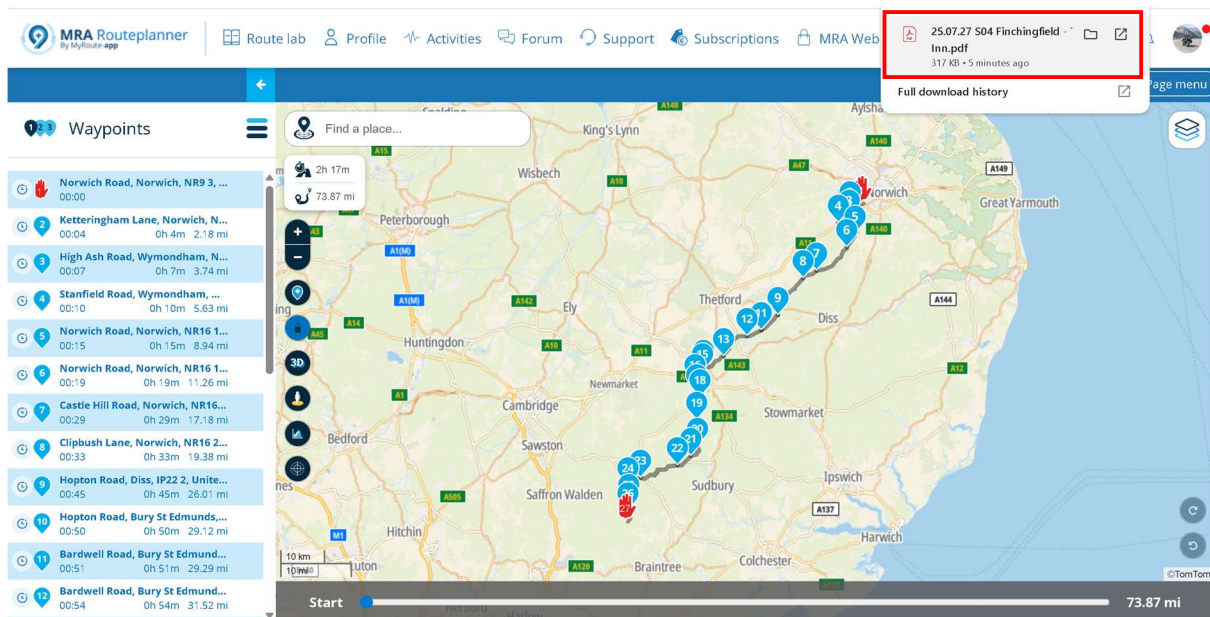
4. Select and open the page menu button at the top right-hand corner (As shown above).



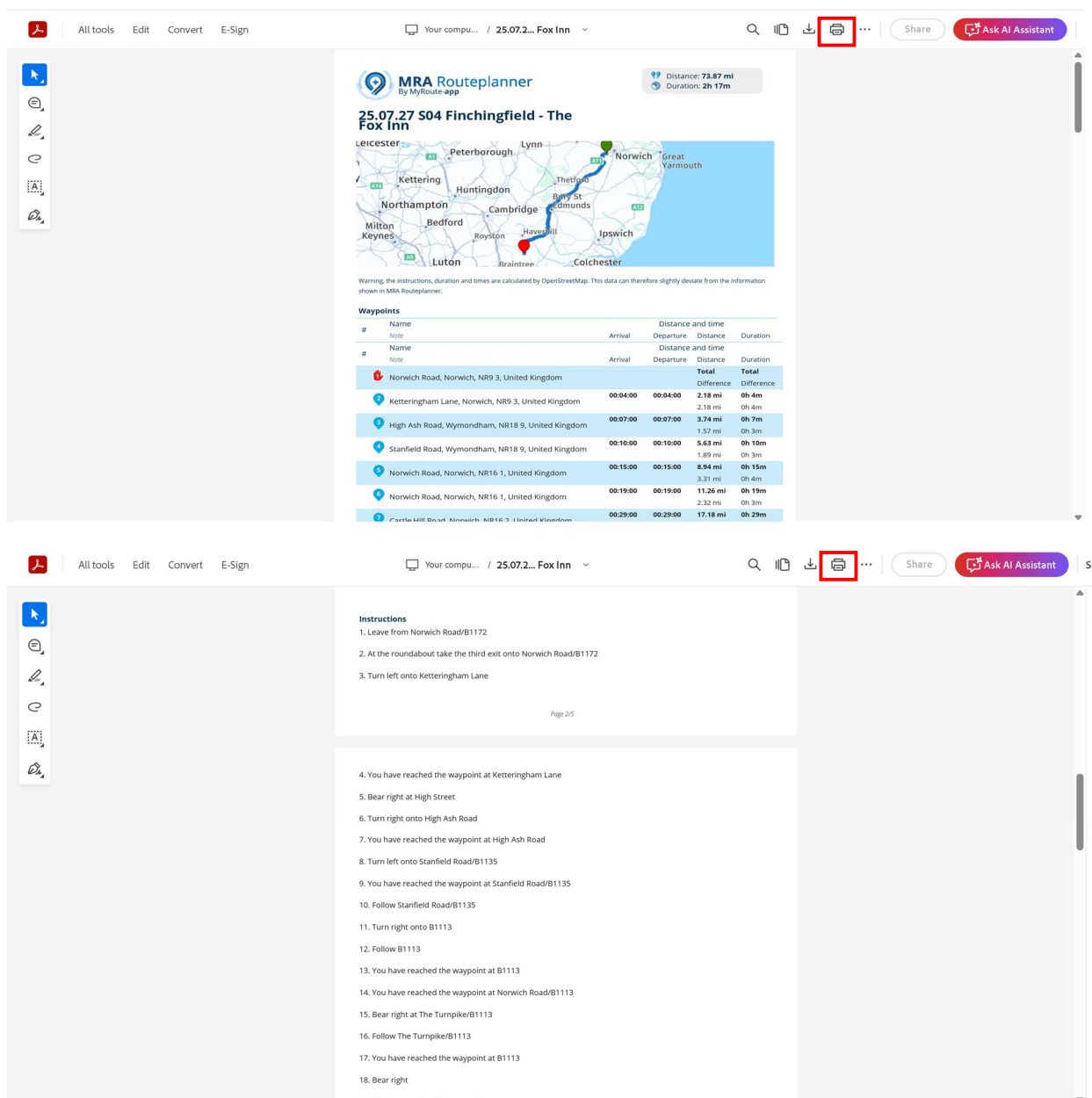
5. Click "save as" and using the scroll bar to the right side, scroll down nearly to the bottom of the page (As shown above).



6. And then click “.pdf” (As shown above).



7. This will then download and save a .pdf copy of the route onto your PC/Laptop or tablet/android device (As shown above).



8. If you click on that downloaded file, it will open the following .pdf, in a turn-by-turn format. This can now be printed directly from your pdf reader if you have a printer, or as I have already suggested, copied or saved onto a memory stick and taken to your nearest library to print, there would be a small cost involved. (As shown above).

Congratulation you have now successfully printed your first ever route in turn-by-turn instruction form.
